MINISTRY PAYS TRIBUTE TO FORMER MINISTER SENATOR MARTIN R. JOSEPH



The Ministry of National Security pays tribute to former Minister of National Security, Senator Martin R Joseph who died on Monday January 5th, 2015.

Mr. Joseph served this country in many capacities, including Minister of National Security during the period 10 November, 2003 - 25 May, 2010.

He was a management professional and strategic thinker, who with the support of the Ministry's technical staff, focused on the implementation of policies and systems that provided a platform for increased efficiency and effectiveness throughout the divisions of the Ministry of National Security.

While he was extremely task driven, he also took the time to meet on a continuous basis with Heads of Division, Heads of Sections and General Administration staff in driving the work programme of the Ministry. Mr Joseph also demonstrated an acute sensitivity to recognising staff of the Ministry for their commitment.

At the international level, he served as Chair of the Inter-American Committee against Terrorism from 2005 to 2006 and Chairman of the CARICOM Council of Ministers for National Security and Law Enforcement over the period 2006-2010.
