### **CONTINUED SUSPENSION OF SERVICES BY THE WORK PERMIT SECRETARIAT AND THE CITIZENSHIP AND RESIDENCY UNIT**

**Port of Spain:** The Ministry of National Security wishes to advise that services provided by its Work Permit Secretariat and its Citizenship and Residency Unit located at Temple Court 2, 52-60 Abercromby Street, Port of Spain remain suspended to the general public until July 18, 2021 as part of Government's precautionary measures aimed at mitigating the spread of COVID-19.

Completed forms are to be submitted via a drop box located in the lobby of Temple Court 2.
