MINISTRY OF NATIONAL SECURITY

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED AND PROCEDURE WHEN APPLYING FOR OVERSEAS MISSIONARIES PERMIT:

- 1. Application must be completed, signed and dated by the applicant. (Non-nationals of Trinidad and Tobago).
- 2. Application must be accompanied by:
 - i) Two (2) photographs of the applicant.
 - ii) Police Certificate of Character from country of residence.
- 3. All applications must be accompanied by a covering letter from the local organization with which the applicant is affiliated.

This letter should state:-

- i) The applicant's name.
- ii) The expected date of arrival.
- iii) The period of stay in Trinidad and Tobago.
 - iv) Whether the applicant will be remunerated or not.
 - v) Purpose of visit.
- vi) Number of foreign Missionaries in the organization who have been granted Missionary Permits by the Government of Trinidad and Tobago.
- vii) Whether the applicant has previously been issued a Missionary Permit in Trinidad and Tobago.
- 4. Both the application and the covering letter must be submitted in duplicate.
- 5. In cases of newly formed organizations, a copy of the 'Certificate of Registration' under the Companies Ordinance of Trinidad and Tobago' must be submitted.
- 6. In cases where extensions are required, the requirements at 1 to 4 must be fulfilled with the exception of 2(ii). In this instance:
 - i) Where a person has been in the country for six (6) months or more, a Police Certificate of Character from the local district in which the person has been residing must be submitted.
- 7. Specimen signature/s of the person/s authorised to act on behalf of the organization must be submitted.
- 8. Applications must be submitted at least six (6) weeks in advance of the applicant's date of arrival into Trinidad and Tobago.
- 9. A fee of \$500 per year (or part thereof) is payable on approval of the application for Missionary Permit.
