CUSTOMS OFFICERS TRAINED TO IDENTIFY HUMAN TRAFFICKING



The Ministry of National Security's Counter Trafficking Unit (CTU) continues to equip border officers with the necessary expertise to Effectively Screen persons for Human Trafficking Indicators. On Wednesday 06 April, 2022, training was delivered to a group of 15 specially identified officers from the Customs and Excise Division, Ministry of Finance.
