PRISON SERVICE HOSTS ANNUAL INMATES' ART EXHIBITION



Minister of National Security the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P. officially opened the Trinidad and Tobago Prison Service's 11th Annual Inmates' Art Exhibition, held in collaboration with the National Library and Information System (NALIS), at NALIS Head Office, Abercromby Street, Port of Spain on Wednesday June 01, 2022.

The Minister noted that, even though the COVID-19 pandemic temporarily halted this annual event, the inmates continued to refine their artistic skills as part of their rehabilitation process. The exhibition is part of the Trinidad and Tobago Prison Service's larger programme for rehabilitation and restoration.


