

Trinidad and Tobago's counter trafficking efforts were the focus of discussions at a meeting between Minister of National Security the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P. and Mr. Shante Moore, Charge d'Affaires of the Embassy of the United States of America in Trinidad and Tobago held on August 15, 2022 at the Ministry's head office on Abercromby Street, Port of Spain.



POLICE SERVICE PROMOTES 258 OFFICERS

The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) presented letters of promotion to 258 officers in a brief ceremony held on August 17, 2022 at the Police Academy, St. James.

At one of the largest promotion exercises hosted by the TTPS since 2016, 257 officers were promoted from the rank of Corporal to Sergeant while one officer was promoted from Sergeant to Inspector. The process involved a review of the promotion system to meet the organisation's strategic priority of developing effective leaders.

During his address, **Acting Commissioner** of Police Mr. Mc Donald Jacob noted the significance of the promotions and said that it would augur well in motivating and building the morale of the both newly promoted officers and others in the organisation.
