Trinidad and Tobago commemorated its 60th Anniversary of Independence (Diamond Jubilee) with the customary Independence Day Military Parade at the Queen's Park Savannah in Trinidad and the Dwight Yorke Stadium Parade Grounds in Tobago, on Wednesday August 31, 2022.
