MINISTER HINDS HOSTS SIGNING CEREMONY



On Monday December 19, 2022, Minister of National Security, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P., hosted a Signing Ceremony for an Exchange of Letters with Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the People's Republic of China to Trinidad and Tobago, His Excellency Fang Qiu, with regard to the construction of a new Trinidad and Tobago Forensic Science Centre (TTFSC).

The new Forensic Science Centre will be located on Farm Road, St. Joseph, and will have dedicated spaces and laboratories for biology, chemistry, toxicology, documents, ballistics, motor vehicles, pathological anatomy and other technical inspections, storage rooms, administrative office rooms, electrical and standby power rooms and other supporting facilities.

The Signing Ceremony took place at the Ministry of National Security's Office at Tower C, International Waterfront Complex, Port of Spain.

OLEP PRESENTS DRAFT POLICIES TO MINISTER HINDS



Drafts of the Firearm Users Licenses (FUL) Policy, as well as the National Border Security Policy were presented to the Minister of National Security, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P. on Monday 18 December, 2022, by Director of the Office of Law Enforcement Policy (OLEP), Ms. Gale Charles, at a brief handover ceremony held at the Ministry of National Security, Abercromby Street, Port of Spain.

Speaking at the Handover Ceremony, Minister Hinds thanked OLEP for its work on both policy documents and commended them for presenting thorough documents.

Also giving remarks at the ceremony was OLEP Director, Ms. Charles, who said that the Draft Policies will be critical in improving law enforcement policies and provide guidelines for more efficient border control and migration systems which will be based on integrity, coordination, technological capabilities and organisational development.
