PRISON SERVICE RECOGNIZES CONSECRATION OF FLAG ANNIVERSARY AND HOSTS MEMORIAL OBSERVANCE



The Trinidad and Tobago Prison Service commemorated the organization's consecration of flag anniversary and Parade of Colours with a service on Sunday November 06 2022 at the Holy Trinity Church, Arouca. Proceedings also included a street procession, in the Arouca area, to the Golden Grove Prison.

Joining the procession were Commissioner of Prisons (Ag.) Mr. Deopersad Ramoutar and other members of the Prison Service Executive. The day's activities also included a Memorial Day Observance at Prison Service's Memorial Garden, Golden Grove.

Speaking at the two-fold event, Commissioner (Ag.) Ramoutar brought words of encouragement to prison officers, noting their dedicated service in the organization's pursuit of restorative justice practices. He also recognized the solemn memorial occasion and paid tribute to fallen prison officers.
