MNS MOURNS THE PASSING OF MS. ANN MARIE ALLEYNE- DALY

The Ministry of National Security and by extension the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service, mourns the passing of Pioneering First Acting Female Commissioner, Ms. Ann Marie Alleyne-Daly (1957-2023).

Alleyne-Daly, who sadly passed away on Tuesday of this week, is described as a “lady of first,” having been the first policewoman to act as Commissioner of Police in 2014, among other accolades.

Ms. Alleyne-Daly who retired in January 2017, had an expansive 41-year policing career, which dated back to her enlistment into the TTPS on September 3, 1976, at the age of 18.
