#### **ODPM LAUNCHES PUBLIC ALERT NOTIFICATION SYSTEM**



A Public Alert Notification System (PANS) has been launched as part of this year's National Disaster Prevention and Preparedness Month (NDPPM). The NDPPM 2023 initiative was launched on Friday 28 April, 2023, at the Alternate National Emergency Operations Centre (ANEOC), Mausica.

Trinidad and Tobago's Public Alert Notification System (PANS) is a mass notification system that allows the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Management (ODPM) to provide emergency alert information nationally, to an affected area or a specific group. PANS will inform citizens of and visitors to Trinidad and Tobago of critical information during emergencies and provide timely information to protect lives and property.
