MINISTER HINDS COMMISSIONS NEW STREAM GAUGES IN TRINIDAD



Minister of National Security, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P. attended the Commissioning Ceremony of stream flow gauges under the Community Flood Early Warning System Project (CFEWS) at the Diego Martin South Community Centre, on Wednesday 17 May, 2023.

The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in collaboration with the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Management (ODPM) installed five (5) stream gauges in Trinidad, which will be used to monitor riverine levels across the country.

Minister Hinds delivered the feature address and expressed his gratitude to the UNDP for the installation of the flow stream gauges in Trinidad, following the recent commissioning of two (2) similar stations in Tobago.

The stream gauges will enhance the capacity to detect, monitor, analyse, forecast and make decisions that could save lives and property.

CTU SENSITIZES STUDENTS ON HUMAN TRAFFICKING



This week, more than 80 Standard Five students were sensitized on the dangers of Human Trafficking as they prepare to transition to Secondary School. Deputy Director of the Counter Trafficking Unit (CTU), Mrs. Kimoy Thomas-Williams conducted two sensitization sessions with students of the Aranguez T.I.A. Primary School and Barataria Anglican Primary School, on Wednesday 17 and Thursday 18 May, 2023.

Topics covered in the sessions included what is Human Trafficking; types of Human Trafficking; the role of the CTU; who can be a victim of Human Trafficking; signs of Human Trafficking; who can be a Trafficker; online grooming; and reporting suspected cases of Human Trafficking.

The students exhibited a keen interest in the topics covered, especially that of Online Grooming and how they can guard themselves against Human Trafficking.
