MINISTER HINDS WELCOMES 214 NEW TTDF OFFICERS



Minister of National Security the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P., welcomed two hundred and fourteen (214) recruits into the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (TTDF) at a Joint Passing Out Parade on Saturday 03 June, 2023, held at the Teteron Barracks in Chaguaramas.

TTPS CRACKS DOWN ON ILLEGAL DRUGS AND FIREARMS

The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS) conducted several anti-crime exercises throughout the country, in the lead up to the Corpus Christi holiday that resulted in numerous arrests for illegal narcotics, firearms seized and suspects held on gang-related and robbery enquiries.

Officers of the Guard and Emergency Branch participated in various exercises in the Southern Division. During Operation Real Steel in San Fernando, several vehicles were stopped and searched and a 29-year-old fire warden was arrested for Possession of Marijuana for the Purpose of Trafficking. Ten persons were also detained for various offences during a road-block exercise in the North Central Division. Port of Spain Task Force officers also conducted anti-crime exercises and several search warrants for arms and ammunition were executed.

In the North Eastern Division, a collaboration between officers of the North Eastern Division Task Force (NEDTF) and officers of the Central Division resulted in the speedy recovery of a Nissan Tiida that was stolen in the Chaguanas district.

The TTPS continues to conduct these anti-crime exercises as part of its efforts to fight against crime in Trinidad and Tobago.
