#### YOUTH IN FOCUS – 'LIMING WITH A PURPOSE' PROJECT LAUNCHED

On Monday June 26, 2023, Minister of National Security, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P. joined with the National Drug Council of Trinidad and Tobago (NDC), for the launch of 'Liming with a Purpose' – Engaging to be informed, Educate and Empower on the issues of drug control. The project



is a community youth networking initiative, developed in collaboration with youth representatives of the NDC Planning Committee and was unveiled in recognition of the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime's (UNODC) International Day against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking, observed annually on June 26.

Delivering the feature address at the Launch, Minister Hinds stated that treating with violent crime, drug abuse and drug trafficking, especially among the young population, continues to be a priority for Trinidad and Tobago. He noted that it is only through collective efforts, that stakeholders can mitigate drug abuse and drug trafficking among the youth.

'Liming with a purpose' is designed to: better understand the key pull and push factors that are engaging the youth population in drug control matters, with a view to addressing the issue; provide options to assist youth in decision making; and to create a network of young people in communities, to partake in robust, solution driven youth-led conversations. It is envisioned that these efforts will culminate with the development of drug-free initiatives, for sharing with Government Ministries, for implementation.

The project will run from July 2023 to May 2024 in five (5) communities: Chaguanas, St. Joseph, Sangre Grande, Laventille and Bethel Tobago.

### TT DEFENCE FORCE PARTICIPATES IN REGIONAL MILITARY EXERCISE



A contingent from the Trinidad and Tobago Defence Force (TTDF) participated in a military exercise consisting of a skills competition between military and police Special Operations teams from the Western Hemisphere. The exercise, Fuerzas Comando 2023, organized by the U.S. Southern Command, was hosted in the Dominican Republic from June 12-22, 2023. Teams from twenty (20) countries, took part in the initiative, aimed at promoting military-to-military relationships, increasing training knowledge and improving regional security. Activities also included a Senior Leadership Seminar.

On June 21, 2023, Chief of Defence Staff, Air Vice Marshal Darryl Daniel and TTDF Force Command Senior Enlisted Advisor Warrant Officer Class 1 Rian Dillon paid a visit to the TTDF contingent and met with senior military officials present.
