

REDUCING FLOOD IMPACT IN TOBAGO

On Monday 27th March 2023, the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Management (ODPM) participated in the official launch of the Community Flood Early Warning Systems (CFEWS) project in Tobago.

At the launch, two stream flow gauges were unveiled as part of the multistakeholder initiative aimed to reduce flood impacts and strengthen community capacity and resilience.

Additionally, five such stream flow gauges have been installed across Trinidad in communities consistently impacted by floods.
