MINISTER OF NATIONAL SECURITY MEETS WITH FRENCH OFFICIALS



On Wednesday September 27, 2023, Minister of National Security, the Honourable Fitzgerald Hinds M.P., met with His Excellency Didier Chabert, Ambassador of France and Lieutenant Colonel Gregory Charvieux, Non-Resident Defence Attaché of the French Armed Forces in the Caribbean.

Discussions were held on the Draft Technical Arrangement between the Minister of National Security of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and the Minister of Defence of the French Republic. This arrangement will give effect to the participation of Trinidad and Tobago in Joint Military Cooperation Activities in the Territory of the French Republic with the French Armed Forces in the Caribbean.

TTPS CARAVAN TRAINS OVER 2000 STUDENTS AND TEACHERS IN CONFLICT RESOLUTION



The Trinidad and Tobago Police Service recently hosted a Conflict Resolution Caravan (CRC), which brought noticeable improvement in classroom dynamics to ten (10) secondary schools across Trinidad.

This was the feedback from scores of principals, teachers, students and participants, who were trained in promoting peaceful coexistence and effective communication during the CRC.

The CRC programme which ran from September 11th to 19th, 2023, engaged 2526 teachers and students. Its aim was to foster collaboration with local educational authorities, community leaders, and relevant stakeholders to broaden the reach and effectiveness of future conflict resolution initiatives.

According to the Coordinator of the CRC and Head of the St Joseph Police Youth Club (SJPYC), WPC Ms. Sascha Williams-Goddard, the response from students was overwhelmingly positive, reflecting their eagerness to acquire and apply conflict resolution skills to a host of situations encountered in the classroom and school campuses.

The TTPS plans to administer subsequent cycles of conflict resolution training, by way of the CRC, so as to continue to build on the momentum already achieved. The intent is to keep strengthening community relationships and reaching more teachers and students in schools across Trinidad and Tobago
