Trinidad and Tobago commemorated its National Day of Remembrance on Sunday November 12, 2023 at Memorial Park in Port of Spain and at the APT James Memorial Park in Scarborough, Tobago. This event was held in honour and memory of all who served and died in the line of duty during the World Wars of 1914–1918 and 1939–1945. The event was observed with a wreath laying ceremony and military parade.
