ODPM CONDUCTS TSUNAMI EVACUATION DRILL



On Tuesday 28 November, 2023, the Office of Disaster Preparedness and Management (ODPM) partnered with the Mayaro/ Rio Claro Regional Corporation's Disaster Management Unit (DMU) for the coordination of a Tsunami Evacuation Exercise.

In the Mayaro district, the DMU undertook mitigation initiatives, guided by the Sendai Framework's Priorities for Action, to reduce the Kernahan community's vulnerabilities to coastal impacts and build capacity through awareness and evacuation practice.

WHAT'S HAPPENING

The simulation exercise was centered on an impending tsunami, where the DMU alerted Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) members to assist with the activation of the Early Warning System (EWS) in the community, such as sirens and responders to assist with the evacuation.

Also participating in the exercise were members of the Mayaro community, the Trinidad and Tobago Police Service (TTPS), the Trinidad and Tobago Fire Service (TTFS), the Trinidad and Tobago Coast Guard (TTCG), and the Eastern Regional Health Authority (ERHA).
