The Transit Police Constable is responsible for enforcing and maintaining law and order in defined areas of the Transportation Sub-Sector.

- Performs regular foot and mobile patrols, makes arrests, settles disputes, issues citations, and provides passengers with assistance and direction.

- Participates in special operations such as road blocks and searches of vehicles/persons.
- Attends court as a complainant or witness.
- Records, serves and executes warrants, summonses and other official documents as directed by relevant authority.

- Investigates reports and incidents of a criminal nature and prosecutes offenders as required

The Transit Police Corporal directly supervises a squad of Transit Police Constables and is responsible for enforcing and maintaining law and order in defined areas of the Transportation Sub-Sector.

REPORTS TO:	Transit Police Sergeant and/or any other senior officer
SUPERVISION GIVEN TO:	Transit Police Constables

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Supervises the activities of Police Constables assigned to a shift and assists a Police Sergeant in supervising the operations of an assigned shift.
- Visits officers on assignments to observe their appearance and activities and gives guidance or direction where necessary.
- Performs regular foot or mobile patrols, makes arrests, settles disputes, issues citations, and provides passengers with assistance and direction.
- Responds to calls for service within a specific area of operations.
- Directs and controls the flow of traffic and enforces traffic laws as necessary.
- Participates in special operations such as roadblocks and searches of vehicles/persons.
- Attends court as a complainant or witness.
- Records, serves and executes warrants, summonses and other official documents as directed by relevant authority.
- Participates in programmes aimed at promoting safety and security within the public transportation system.
